



Industrial Building / Maintenance Mechanic:

Position Summary: Repairs and maintains machinery and mechanical equipment such as engines, motors, pneumatic tools, conveyor systems, and production machines and equipment.

Duties and Responsibilities

- Abides OSHA and CMF rules and regulations for safety.
- Wear typical protection gear in non-air-conditioned environment that contain dust, odors and noise.
- Work well under pressure.
- Repairs and maintains hydraulic, mechanical, electrical, and pneumatic manufacturing equipment.
- Repair and or diagnosis of overhead cranes, forklifts and hoists.
- Repair typical building issues (within reason) as our building is over 100 years old
- Inspects and troubleshoots machines work properly.
- Diagnose and resolve equipment breakdowns on the production floor
- Run electrical conduit, as well as data and air lines to work areas and equipment
- Evaluate and fix pneumatic, power, and mechanical hand tools
- Complete and turn-in all work order paperwork
- Other duties and responsibilities as assigned.

Physical Demands

- Required to stand for long periods of time and walk frequently.
- Must be able to frequently lift and/or move objects of 75 pounds.
- Must be able to cover other shifts/overtime as necessary.
- Must be able to bend and squat frequently.
- Must be able to stand for 8-10 hours or more daily.

Required Knowledge and/or Experience

- High School Diploma or General Education Degree (GED).
- 5 years minimum relevant technical experience, degree or certifications; Or combination of education and experience.
- Experience working with 3-phase 480V, reading electrical schematics, and troubleshooting DC-motors.
- Welding, HVAC, plumbing, and residential electrical experience a plus
- Ability to read English.
- Must have strong math and measurement skills.
- Must have own tools
